1. Executive Summary

The Clean Waters Initiative aims to improve water quality in the Riverdale community by organizing monthly clean-up events, installing filtration systems, and educating residents. Our project seeks both to address immediate needs and promote sustainable change through community engagement and lasting infrastructure.

2. Organization Background

Riverdale Community Foundation (RCF) is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to environmental stewardship and promoting community health through collaborative action.

3. Statement of Need

Polluted waterways threaten Riverdale's environment, health, and economy. Recent studies confirm unsafe bacteria levels and visible debris in the main waterway. Without intervention, public health and biodiversity will deteriorate.

4. Project Description

Objectives

- Reduce water pollution and visible waste by 50% over 12 months.
- Engage 300 local volunteers in clean-up and awareness events.
- Install 2 water filtration units at key river points.

Activities

- Monthly riverbank clean-up events.
- School and community workshops on pollution prevention.
- Installation and ongoing maintenance of filtration systems.
